Patrick Daude is a German expert in international cooperation and urban mobility. He is Licentiate in International Relations (State University of Uruguay, Law Faculty) with a M.A. in European Labor Studies (University of Bremen, Germany). His main fields of activity are international networks of local and regional governments, branding of cities, and management of European projects as well as coordination of activities in the area of corporate mobility management and mobility culture. After working at the Coordination Office of the URB-AL Network “Towns and the Information Society”, lead by the Free Hanseatic City of Bremen on behalf of the European Commission, he joined the policy staff of the Mayor of Stuttgart. There Mr. Daude has been working since August 2006 as coordinator of the international network “Cities for Mobility”, which he helped to build up. The network is coordinated by the Municipality of Stuttgart and promotes the exchange of experiences and know-how between cities and organizations from business, research and civil society world-wide. In 2013, when Fritz Kuhn took office as Mayor, Mr. Daude started to be more deeply involved in coordinating strategic processes on the local level, focusing on public awareness campaigns, citizen participation and cooperation with research, civil society, and the private sector.
