Your data is stored after collection for the duration of your membership. Statutory data and document retention periods may require your data to be stored beyond the duration of your membership.

You have the following rights according to the EU General Data Protection Regulation:

If your personal data is processed, you have the right to obtain information regarding the storage of your personal data (Section 15 GDPR). If incorrect personal data is processed, you have the right to correction of such (Section 16 GDPR). If legal requirements are given, you have the right to request the deletion or limitation of processing, and you have the right to object to such processing (Sections 17, 18 and 21 GDPR). In the event of an objection, we will no longer be able to reach you as our member, and membership with our organization will be terminated. Since data processing is based on a contract, and since data processing is carried out via automated processes, you have a right to data portability where applicable (Section 20 GDPR).
